A New Bishop for London: Sarah Mullally in Conversation

Following her historic installation as the 133rd Bishop of London, Sarah Mullally will be in conversation with the Dean of St Paul's Cathedral on Monday, 4th June 6.30pm-8pm in the Cathedral.

Bishop Sarah will talk about her faith, her life, what matters to her most, and how she feels about her appointment.

She was installed on 12 May in the Cathedral (some members of St John's were able to attend this service), she was previously Bishop of Crediton, has worked at Salisbury Cathedral and been a parish priest, and before had a career as a nurse, specialising in cancer care. Her very successful career in the NHS culminated in her appointment as the government's Chief Nursing Officer for England at the age of 37, and she was made a Dame Commander of the British Empire in 2005 in recognition of her outstanding contribution to nursing and midwifery.
