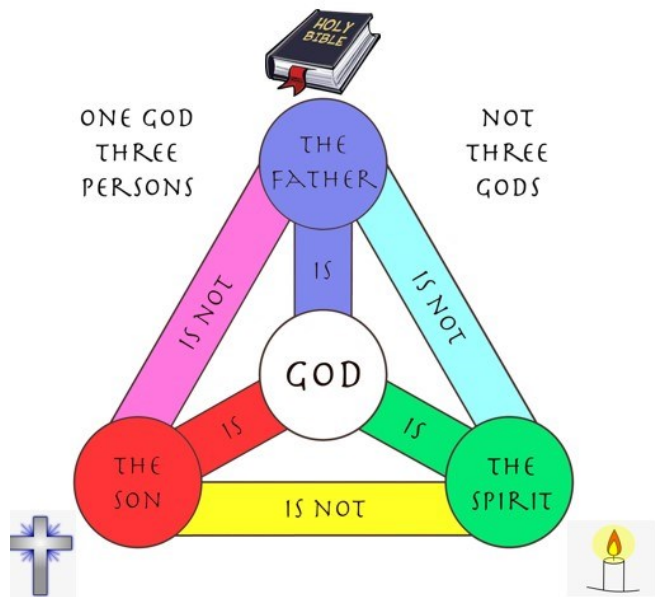
Post Communion
