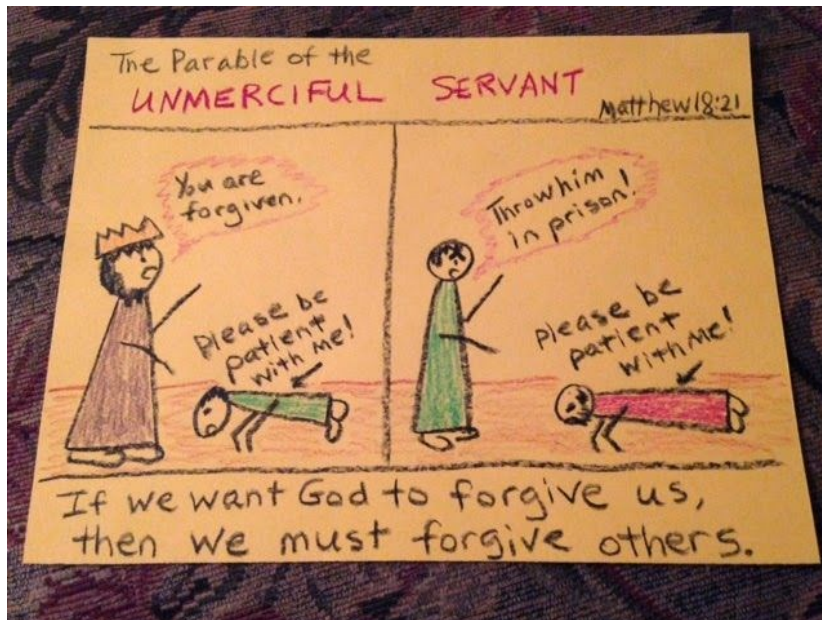

Old Rectory Development Plans Meeting - 18th September

The Diocese of London sold the Old Rectory in 2017 to the Harrow Churches Housing Association who intended to build a new Wolstenholme (sheltered housing scheme). It has been sold again as their plans changed.

The latest proposal is to build a short-stay/post-operative centre which will offer programmes tailored for patients recovering from orthopaedic surgery and related conditions.
