Please pray for Helen as she prepares to be ordained deacon on Saturday 27th June at 3pm in St Paul's Cathedral. 10 members of our church family will be attending the service, along with Matthew and Rachel.

Helen will be a deacon for her first year of ordination, and her role is primarily about service in the church.

A deacon can preach and teach, carry out pastoral care, baptise, take funerals, lead worship and assist at Holy Communion.
